Landowner assumes responsibility for ensuring that this non-public water well is constructed by a water well driller who is licensed to work in Kansas. This water well must be constructed according to regulation in ARTICLE 30--WATER WELL CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE WATER WELL CONSTRUCTION AND ABANDONMENT regulating the construction, reconstruction, treatment and plugging of water wells and sets forth procedures for the licensing of water well contractors as required by K.S.A. 82a-1201 to 82a1215 and amendments thereto.

This permit holder agrees to meet all applicable regulation pertaining to the County Environmental Code for one of the following counties: Clark, Finney, Grant, Hamilton, Hodgeman, Kearny, Meade, and Stanton.
